- Development of the area behind Eagles mobile - this was also liked and all would like it to be a quiet area that is environmentally friendly (log seats, etc)
- Development of the library area outside the Hall - very much wanted. Colourful, comfortable furniture and classes timetabled to use, including playtimes/lunchtimes
- Healthy Lunch Box Scheme - not terribly popular as all say it is fine as it is. We will need to look into this further though!
- Return of the Record Breakers playtime - a good idea although it was quite a lot of work to organise. Year 6 would need to take this on of wanted.
- Add to the Play Trail - definitely!
- Have a swing and slide and link this to Huff and Puff - a nice idea but on reflection all decided it would be dangerous and use up a lot of space but could only be used by a few children at a time
- Have a new basketball hoop - definitely (something to buy with School Council budget)
- Each class nominate two people to be Playtime Buddies each day to help lonely children - all liked this idea and we would like to have buddy caps to identify themselves on the playground
- Have a Healthy Food tuck shop at playtime - this is a popular idea but needs more discussion
- Astroturf some of the field to extend the playground - definitely
